## Rove for the Prophet

The Prophet Muhammad 🚟 said: "Whoever possesses the following three qualities will have the sweetness (delight) of faith: (a) The one to whom Allah and His Messenger become dearer than anything else; (b) Who loves a person and he loves him only for Allah's Sake; (c) Who hates to revert to disbelief after Allah has brought (saved) him out from it, as he hates to be thrown into a fire.

Narrated by Abdullah bin Hisham: "We were with the Prophet 💥 and he was holding the hand of 'Umar bin Al-Khattab. 'Umar said to Him, "O Allah's Messenger! You are dearer to me than everything except my own self." The Prophet said, "No, by Him in Whose Hand my soul is, (you will not have complete faith) till I am dearer to you than your own self." Then 'Umar said to him, "However, now, by Allah, you are dearer to me than my own self." The Prophet said, "Now, O 'Umar (now you are a believer)." Bukhari

Learning his Seerah

 Family times or home study circle
 Knowledge will increase fondness, attachment to, and belief in him
 Increase desire to follow his example

Surturing Rove for the Prophet

 Stories of Companions -Read how the Prophet Loved his Companions -Read how Companions loved and respected the Prophet -Realize importance of this and desire to emulate them

Surturing Rove for the Prophet

Following his Example

 Apply his way in words, deeds,
 obedience to commands, avoidance
 of whatever he prohibited





### Hurturing Rove for the Prophet

Surturing Rove for the Prophet

 Children should be taught the Sunnah of the Prophet 🚟 in all areas of life -Through learning Hadeeth • Memorize and learn meaning -Benefits of following Sunnah -Supplications -Sending blessings upon Prophet

Surturing Rove for the Prophet

Children should be reminded that they are following Prophet's sexample when engage in these behaviors and supplications

 Teach children to yearn to meet the Prophet in the Hereafter

 One of rewards awaiting them
 Something should strive for (in addition to seeing Allah)

### Pearning to Meet the Prophet

Narrated 'Aishah, "A man came to the Prophet and said, "O Allah's Messenger! Verily, you are more beloved to me than myself, and verily you are more beloved to me than my family and more beloved to me than my children. And verily, when I am at home and I remember you then I cannot be patient until I come to you and I look at you. And when I contemplate about my death and your death, I know that when you enter Paradise, you will be raised with the Prophets and that if I enter Paradise, I fear that I will not see you."

Pearning to Meet the Prophet

The Prophet did not respond to him until Jibreel brought down this Ayah, "And whosoever obeys Allah and the Messenger, then they **will** be in the company of those on whom Allah has bestowed His Grace, of the Prophets, As-Siddigeen, the martyrs, and the righteous. And how excellent these companions are!"" (4:69)

Anas said, "We had never been as glad as we were on hearing that saying of the Prophet 🕮 'You will be with those whom you love.' Hence, I love the Prophet and Abu Bakr and 'Umar, and I hope that I will be with them because of my love for them though my deeds are not similar to theirs."
